

## CAMP FLIX RULES

- 1) Camp Flix campers are expected to treat each other (and the staff) with kindness and respect.
- 2) Camp Flix campers are expected to treat the university facilities, including dorm rooms, classrooms, public spaces, etc....with care and respect. We are guests on their campus.
- 3) Day campers have no reason to be in the rooms of overnight campers unless approved by camper and counselor.
- 4) The following rules are cause for instant dismissal:
  - No physical violence
  - No drugs, alcohol or tobacco products
  - No derogatory or discriminatory language used towards any campers or staff member.
  - No weapons of any type.
- 5) Campers should never be away from their group without permission from their counselors. Younger campers should always have a staff member with them at all times.
- 6) Filmmaking is a collaborative process, picking which story ideas get made will be group decisions. All campers will have a significant role in front of or behind the camera on their production.
- 7) Treat the equipment with love and care. This is professional gear that we rent for the summer and needs to be returned in the same condition we receive in.
- 8) Camp Flix campers and staff should only be in designated areas (dorms, public spaces, classrooms, etc...). Other buildings including those that house administrative staff, the Chapel, the library, etc....require permission before we can shoot there. In those cases, we must be quiet and clean up after ourselves.
- 9) There are additional rules for our Overnight campers which can also lead to an instant dismissal. Overnight campers and parents are asked to read and sign the rules upon check-in.
- 10) Please note that no refunds are given to those who have broken the rules and have been dismissed from camp.
