# GETTING READY FOR CAMP FLIX

## WHAT PARENTS AND CAMPERS NEED TO KNOW BEFORE COMING TO CAMP FLIX

This packet contains information you need for Camp Flix this summer. We are looking forward to another great summer. If you have any questions, please e-mail us at <a href="mailto:tkarsch@campflix.com">tkarsch@campflix.com</a> or call us at 404-863-6778.

Included within this packet are medical forms that should be brought by your camper and presented during check-in on the first day. Your child will not be able to participate in camp activities unless medical forms, including one signed by your physician, are turned in at check-in on Sunday or Monday.

You will receive several e-mails from us prior to the start of camp and they will include directions on where to pick-up and drop-off your kids. For all returning campers, it will be in the same place as last summer.

Please note that we do allow campers to bring cell phones to camp (they are especially beneficial during afternoon pick-up) but they do so at their own risk. We will be setting guidelines with the campers about when they can and cannot be used at the Monday morning orientation session; those guidelines will be enforced during the week by our counselors and instructors.

#### **DAY CAMPERS ONLY:**

- Drop off and pick up at Emory University is in front of the Longstreet-Means dormitory (646 Means Drive) while at Oglethorpe University drop-off is at the horseshoe driveway at the entrance to the school (4484 Peachtree Road).
- Drop off from Monday to Friday is between 8:30am and 9:00am each day. Camp activities begin at 9:00am. Please do not drop off before 8:30am, there will be no supervision available.
- Pick-up on Monday thru Thursday is at 4:30pm at the same place that you dropped off in the morning. We ask that you not arrive too early as campers will not be released until 4:30pm.
- Lunch can be purchased as part of the registration process. Both Emory and Oglethorpe Universities offer all-you-can-eat, buffet lunches that include vegetarian options. Campers are also allowed to bring their own lunch. If you initially did not sign up for the meal plan but would like to purchase, please let us know at <a href="mailto:tkarsch@campflix.com">tkarsch@campflix.com</a> and we will try to accommodate.
- On Friday night we will screen the short films that your kids made during the week at our Hollywood-style gala premiere. From 5:30pm to 6:00pm the camper crews will walk the red carpet and pose for pictures taken by parents and the paparazzi. Our screening program will start at 6:00pm and last 90+ minutes. Day campers are released with their parents at the completion of the program.
- All campers will be fed at our pre-premiere pizza party.

#### **OVERNIGHT CAMPERS ONLY:**

- Sunday drop-off is between 4:00pm and 5:00pm at the dormitories we are using at Emory (Longstreet-Means) and Oglethorpe (Magbee). Please remember to bring all appropriate medical forms when you check your son/daughter in. You are free to escort them to their rooms or we can have one of our staff take them up.
- The dorm rooms at Emory University tend to be the traditional two to a room with a common bathroom on the floor. The rooms at Oglethorpe are suites that contain four single rooms, two shared bathrooms and a small common area. The individual rooms can not be locked but all overnight campers will have keycards for their suite.
- There are vending machines in the dorms but they often not filled or not working. Feel free to pack snacks for your camper.
- Pick-Up is immediately following the Friday night premiere. Campers will be given time to pack their bags prior to the premiere so they are ready to check out immediately following. Campers/Parents need to turn in their keys and/or meal cards before leaving campus. There is a \$25 charge for all key cards lost and the universities charge us \$75 for lost or unreturned keys.
- You need to pack the following items for your camper:
  - -A week's worth of clothes including clothes for the Friday night premiere (if they want to dress up. If camper is attending our two week session, they need to bring the appropriate amount of clothes
  - A pillow, pillow case, 2 twin flat sheets, a blanket, a towel, and washcloth.
  - Toiletries and hygiene supplies (soap, shampoo, tootpaste and toothbrush, deodorant, sunscreen).
- Please note that campers are allowed to bring their cell phones, laptops, Ipads, etc....but do so at their own risk. Camp Flix is not responsible if they are lost or stolen.
