



Overnight Rules

Camp Flix overnight campers are expected to treat each other (and the staff and university) with kindness and respect. We are guests of the University and want to be invited back next year. Please remember that you are sharing facilities with others. Clean up after yourself and share the bathroom time.

Be respectful of others personal space, property, and need for rest. Keep the noise to a dull roar after your roommates have called it a night.

We have a zero tolerance-policy with any infraction. If you break any of the rules listed below, your parents will be called and you will be dismissed. This is being done for your protection and for the protection of the other campers. We are your guardians for the week and we take this role very seriously.

- 1.) Campers may not leave their room/suites after:
 - a. **12 and Under “10:00 pm lights out”**
 - b. **13+ “11:00 pm lights out”**
 - i. Unless with a counselor for a specific reason
- 2.) Campers are only allowed in their own bedrooms/suites
 - a. There are common areas available to meet and socialize in
- 3.) Campers are not to be in the hall areas or rooms of the opposite gender
- 4.) Once evening activities begin (after dinner), campers are not to leave the dorm building without a counselor

There are common area spaces available for socialization with individuals who are not your room

- 5.) No drugs, alcohol or tobacco products
- 6.) No weapons of any type
- 7.) No physical violence
