

Getting Ready for Camp Flix

WHAT PARENTS AND CAMPERS NEED TO KNOW BEFORE COMING TO CAMP FLIX

This packet contains information you need for Camp Flix this summer. We are looking forward to another great summer. If you have any questions, please e-mail us at **tkarsch@campflix.com** or call us at **404-863-6778**.

Medical forms that need to be filled out before your child's session will be available on May 1st. We are trying to simplify this process so that it can all be done online and won't require you to bring forms in at check-in on the first day. Your child will not be able to participate in camp activities unless medical form is submitted prior to the start of camp.

Maps and more detailed instructions will be sent to you approximately 60 and 30 days before the start of your child's camp session, with a third reminder a few days before the start date.

Please note that we do allow campers to bring cell phones to camp (they are especially beneficial during afternoon pick-up) but they do so at their own risk. We will be setting guidelines with the campers about when they can and cannot be used at the Monday morning orientation session; those guidelines will be enforced during the week by our counselors and instructors.

DAY CAMPERS ONLY

- Drop-off and pick-up for Emory University sessions will be in front of Few Hall (4 Eagle Row) We are using a different dormitory than previous years, and the residence hall serves as our home base for Camp Flix.
- Drop off from Monday to Friday is between 8:30am and 9:00am each day. Camp activities begin at 9:00am. Please do not drop off before 8:30am, there will be no supervision available.
- Pick-up on Monday thru Thursday is at 4:30pm at the same place that you dropped off in the morning. We ask that you do not arrive for pick-up before 4:30pm.
- Lunch is held in the on-campus cafeteria and the cost is included in the registration fee. Emory offers an all-you-can-eat buffet that includes vegetarian options.
- On Friday night we will screen the short films that your kids made during the week at our Hollywood-style gala premiere. From 5:30pm to 6:00pm the camper crews will walk the red carpet and pose for pictures taken by parents and the paparazzi. Our screening program will start at 6:00pm and last 90+ minutes. Day campers are released with their parents at the completion of the program.

OVERNIGHT CAMPERS ONLY

- Sunday drop-off is between 4:30pm to 5:30pm. We ask that you not come before 4:30pm and if you will be arriving after 5:30pm, please let us know. This year we will be using Few Hall (4 Eagle Row) as our residence hall and home base.
- The rooms in Few Hall are traditional two-to-a-room with a common bathroom on the floor.
- There are vending machines in the residence halls but they are often not filled or not working so we suggest that you pack snacks for your campers.
- Pick-Up is immediately following the Friday night premiere. Campers will be given time to pack their bags prior to the premiere so they are ready to check out immediately following. Campers/Parents need to turn in their keys and/or meal cards before leaving campus.
- You need to pack the following items for your camper:
 - A week's worth of clothes including clothes for the Friday night premiere (if they want to dress up).
 - A pillow, pillow case, 2 twin xl flat sheets, a blanket, a towel, and washcloth.
 - Toiletries and hygiene supplies (soap, shampoo, tootpaste and toothbrush, deodorant, sunscreen).
 - Refillable water bottle, shower shoes.
- Please note that campers are allowed to bring their cell phones, laptops, lpads, etc.... but do so at their own risk. Camp Flix is not responsible if they are lost or stolen.
